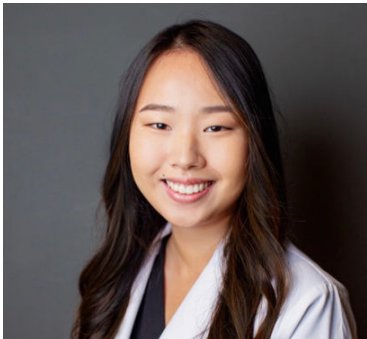

Pharmacy Manager at AxessPointe Community Health Centers



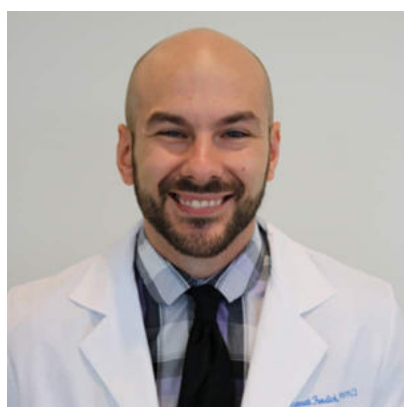

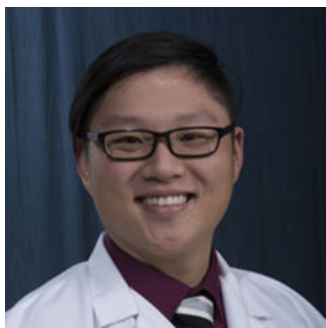
He is actively engaged in research efforts with focuses on creating sustainable pharmacy services, population health, and resident education.
